Mr. and Mrs. McPherson asked about information regarding the Toth Tract/Property. They may refurbish the barn and house on Highspire Road. Part of their plan is to make the barn a livable space for a family. The Commission shared photographs and information about the property.

John Black and James Buczala stated that there is not much federal money available for private properties. If the intent is for a commercial property than there would be more funds available.

The McPhersons thanked the commission for their information.

John Black wants to respond to the Wawa representative's letter to the Army Corp of Engineers. He will draft a letter for the other members to approve.

James Buczala informed the Commission that after conferring with Scott Piersol and David Sweet, the Township versions of the Historic Resource Map (for the Comprehensive Plan and the Township Ordinance) will be generated by Yerkes (Township Engineer). This will allow the historic resource information to be placed as a layer on other township maps and give the Township more direct control of the information. The Ordinance version of the map will include only Class I and Class II that have been formally approved in accordance with the Township Code. The Comprehensive Plan version of the Map will present all information currently known regarding historic resources.

James Buczala showed photographs of the township's premiere historic resources. These will hang in the Township Building.

The commission members approved Steffenie's minutes for the November 14, 2007 Historic Commission meeting.
