John Black stated that Steffenie Kirkpatrick resigned her position on the commission.

John provided a letter written by Scott Piersol that was sent to Dr. James Boyer of the Army Corp of Engineers. The letter contains the township's concerns regarding comments about the February 5, 2008 meeting of concerned parties for the Wawa project.

The commission discussed its position and agreed that the marketing time should be 4 months and the realtor should be given a flat fee for representing the property.

Mr. Inslee was questioning if Wawa knew that the building was a historic resource when they started this process. John Black told Mr. Inslee that the Historical Commission was not meeting when they optioned the property. The township was unclear of the building's designation. Mr. Inslee would be willing to provide an easement to Wawa on his bordering property and has stated so to Wawa.
