Minutes from December meeting were approved.

Two applicants for Open Space Committee membership attended – Andrew Hauer, who moved here from Lancaster 4 ½ years ago and works as an IT consultant for CHOP and Ed Huston, who moved here in 2002 and is retired from Pfizer, where he was manager of Medical Writing. Ed had also attended the previous meeting. We got to know them a little and they were able to ask questions about the process.

Board of Supervisors: This month the board will appoint a new supervisor liaison and reappoint Open Space members.

Planning Commission: Luke Reven showed us the Weaver tract preliminary plan. The Planning Commission has asked for more time to consider it since engineers and other consultants had a number of questions.

Hess Property: They have agreed to the language of the acknowledgement signs to be posted on the property. Signs have not yet been acquired.

Undeveloped properties remaining will have to get Applecross to treat waste and will have to put aside land for drip waste in order to get approval for development. (There will be no stream waste disposal.)

Plank: There are 89 units on the sketch plan.
