



The following items **WILL** be accepted:

- Computers, Laptops, and related equipment. (working and non-working)
- Networking equipment
- Printers and related equipment (working and non-working)
- Office and home electronics (working and non-working)
- LCD Monitors
- Wire, cables, AC adapters
- UPS Batteries
- Open toner cartridges

Accepted equipment that is brought to the event in cardboard boxes or plastic tubs **MUST** be removed from those containers before being added to the received equipment, and the empty containers **MUST** be returned to the persons dropping off.

**Fees that apply:**

- CRT Televisions
  - < 29" - \$20.00 / 30" & above \$40.00
- LCD Televisions
  - \$20.00
- CRT Monitors
  - <18" - \$20.00 / >18"- \$40.00

The following items **WILL NOT** be accepted:

- Smoke Detectors
- Fluorescent Bulbs/Tubes/Lights
- Monitors with broken glass
- Household Alkaline Batteries
- Furniture
- Paper, paper documents, and cardboard
- Electronics in wooden cases (ie. old TV consoles, stereos, and speakers)
- Major appliances such as, but not limited to: washers, dryers, stoves and refrigerators
- Items containing refrigerants such as, but not limited to: refrigerators and air conditioning units

Also, equipment from companies that arrive at the event will not be accepted. Any company that wishes to drop off equipment will be asked to contact us directly in order to take advantage of the services we offer at 1 (877) 332-8681.

Please understand that we are not trying to be difficult about not allowing companies to drop off equipment, but history has shown us that if you allow companies to drop off their equipment you very quickly can get into a situation where there will not be enough help to properly pack the increased volume of equipment in a reasonable amount of time, and that it is almost a guarantee that you will run out of space to transport the equipment on our trucks.
